### ANNOTATIONS OF THE AGENDA

---

- Item 1 Adoption of the Agenda:** In accordance with Rule VI.1 of the Rules of Procedure, the first item on the Provisional Agenda shall be the adoption of the Agenda.
- Item 2 Matters Arising from the Codex Alimentarius Commission and the other Codex Committees:** This item includes matters related to CCFO arising from recent sessions of the Commission and other Committees
- Item 3 Draft Standard for Fat Spreads and Blended Spreads:** The 18<sup>th</sup> Session of Committee discussed this item and decided to return the standard to Step 6 for further comments and considerations at the 19<sup>th</sup> Session. Specifically, with respect to the Section 4 (Food Additives) of the standard, an electronic working group was established by the 18<sup>th</sup> session and the working group submitted the outcome for consideration at the 19<sup>th</sup> session.
- Item 4 Consideration of the Linolenic acid level in Section 3.9 of the Standard for Olive Oils and Olive Pomace Oils:** The 26<sup>th</sup> session of Codex Alimentarius Commission (CAC) in 2003 agreed to adopt the Standard for Olive Oils and Olive Pomace Oils at Step 8, leaving Linolenic acid level in Section 3.9 blank pending the reconsideration of this issue by the Committee based on the outcome of IOOC data survey. The outcome of the IOOC data survey will be issued as working document of CX/FO 05/19/4.
- Item 5 Proposed Draft Amendments to the Standard for Named Vegetable Oils (Rice Bran Oil, Amendment to Sesameseed Oil):** The 18<sup>th</sup> session of the Committee decided to consider, at its next session, addition of Rice Bran Oils to the Standard for Named Vegetable Oils and modification of fatty acid composition of Sesameseed oil in the Standard. These proposals were approved as new work by the 26<sup>th</sup> session of CAC in 2003. Furthermore, it was also proposed in the 18<sup>th</sup> session to consider modifications to some of the botanical names of the original seeds in the Standard for Named Vegetable Oils for consistency between Codex Standard and ISO standard.
- Item 6 Proposed Draft Revised Table 1 of the Recommended International Code of Practice for the Storage and Transport of Edible Fats and Oils in Bulk:** The Committee at its 18<sup>th</sup> session decided to consider amendment of the Table 1 of the *Recommended International Code of Practice for the Storage and Transport of Edible Fats and Oils in Bulk* and this proposal was approved as new work by the 26<sup>th</sup> session of the CAC as accelerated procedure.
- Item 7 Discussion Paper for Criteria for the revision of the Named Vegetable Oils:** The Committee at its 18<sup>th</sup> Session agreed to consider consistent criteria that would enable the Standards for Named Vegetable Oils to cover a new type of vegetable oil whose fatty acid contents were modified from the original oil that had been already included in the Standard, without creating a new definition of the newly developed oil in the Standard. The outcome of the electronic working group, established to consider this issue, will be submitted for discussion.
- Item 8 Other Business, Future Work and Date and Place of the Next Session:** In accordance with Rule VI.5 of the Rules of Procedure, any Member of the Commission may propose the inclusion of specific items of an urgent matter. Proposals to undertake new work on the elaboration of standards and related texts are subject to the approval by the Commission.

**Item 9 Adoption of the Report:** In accordance with Rule IX.1 of the Commission's Rules of Procedure, the Committee shall adopt the report of its 19<sup>th</sup> Session, based on a draft provided by the Secretariat.
